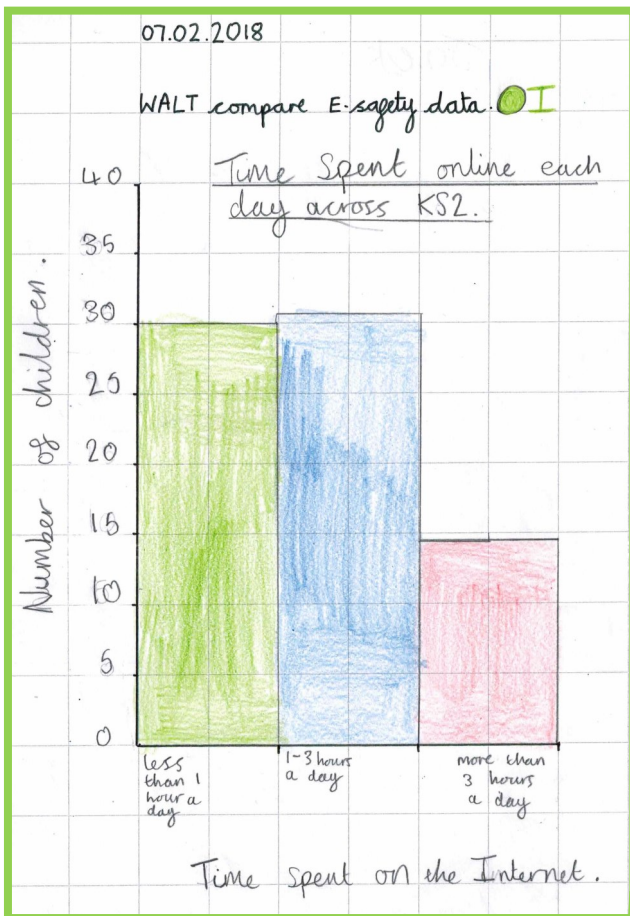


E-Safety 2018

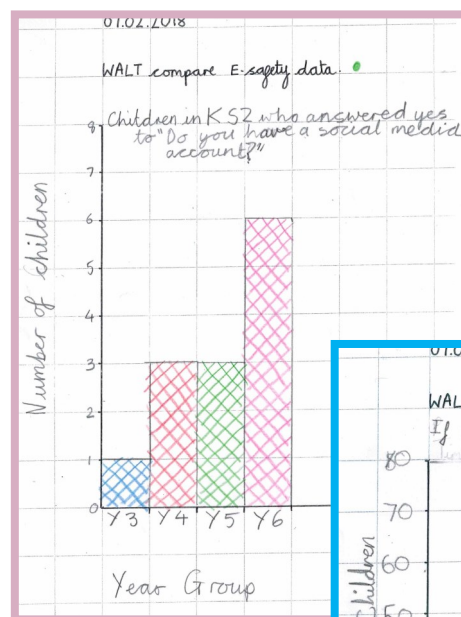

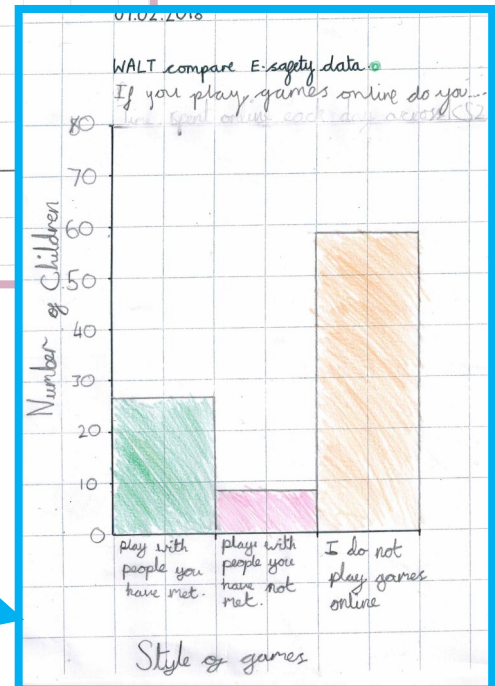


KS2—This shows how much time children say they are spending online each day.
